To be eligible for the Refugee Bursary, you must be:

- 1. A refugee, protected person, or a person displaced by war. The applicant must be currently residing in Canada or have been granted permanent residency after January 1, 2021 due to the above-listed reasons.
- 2. Valid for new students who enroll in a full-time diploma program at Eastern College that starts between August 1, 2022 and July 31, 2023.
- 3. May not be combined with any other bursary or program discount.

Requirements for application:

- 1. A brief one page (500 word) essay outlining the applicant's goals in Canada.
- 2. A copy of the applicant's resume.

Award Value

- 1. The value of this bursary is \$5000.
- 2. All other fees and books are at the student's cost.

Award Payments and Conditions

- 1. The Award will be listed on your student contract. It will be reviewed by our Financial Aid Officer as part of your application to enroll.
- 2. If you withdraw from studies, the value of the Award will be reduced or cancelled, based on standard term withdrawal deadlines.
- 3. The Award has no monetary value other than towards the cost of tuition.
- 4. The fiscal status of the award will be in accordance with the Canadian Income Tax legislation.
